Faculty of Fine Arts, Bunditpatanasilpa Institute

The Faculty of Fine Arts, Bunditpanasilpa Institute is an institution under the Ministry of Culture with the duty to provide education and academic promotion in both Thai and international visual arts and design at the tertiary level. This includes art and culture at the local and national levels. It provides education, art work exhibition, research, academic services as well as promoting, conserving, creating, maintaining and publicizing art and culture which are the national identity and diverse cultures of a local community. Therefore, the Faculty sees the importance of the quality and development of educational standards and it has been recognized continuously. By virtue of the Act on Education Provision at the Undergraduate Level of Bunditpatanasilpa Institute B.E. 2541, which was published in the Government Gazette and came into force on 3 November B.E. 2541, the Faculty has been established since. It began offering a 2 year undergraduate degree (continued) for those who graduated with the High Vocational Certificate from a College of Fine Arts on 4 June B.E. 2552. Following this, it has offered the 4 year Bachelor of Arts Program for students via direct examination since B.E. 2547. The Program consists of 3 Departments: Thai Arts, Fine Arts and Design.
