Faculty of Music and Drama, Bunditpatanasilpa Institute

The objective of the Faculty of Music and Drama, Bunditpatanasilpa Institute is to produce the artists, scholars, and administrators in the fields of Thai classical dance and instrumental and vocal music. The institute has been founded since 1999 and initially accepted students who graduate from colleges of dramatic arts from all over the country. The Faculty offers a 2-year program in three majors: Thai classical dance, Thai classical music, and Thai classical singing. In 2004, a 4-year program, Bachelor of Fine Arts (B.F.A.) in Thai Classical Dance was offered.

In 2005, B.F.A. Program in Thai Classical Music and Thai Classical Singing were offered. In 2017, B.F.A. Program in Thai Folk Music and Performance was offered, with two fields of study: Northeastern Folk Music and Northeastern Folk Dance. The classes are organized through learning network system at Roi Et College of Dramatic Arts and Kalas in College of Dramatic Arts. The Faculty of Music and Drama are aware of the importance of the quality assurance procedure. It focuses on the quality control of our curriculum and teaching. The development of the effective system and protocol to fulfil all aspects of Internal Quality Control which consist of teaching/leaning management, research, community service, and preservation of art and culture is also given importance to.
