

Faculty of Fine Arts, Chiang Mai University

The Faculty of Fine Arts was established according to the direction of Chiang Mai University, the first regional university in Thailand with the aim to be an educational resource for every profession whether it be science and technology, social sciences and arts.

On 28 January B.E. 2525, Chiang Mai University's Council approved the establishment of the Faculty of Fine Arts to be an institution that produced arts graduates and a center for education, discovery, conservation research and publication of art and culture in the northern region.

On 24 March B.E. 2525, the Ministry of University Affairs approved a program making it the 12th Faculty of Chiang Mai University.

On 17 June B.E. 2526, it offered 2 Programs for the first time including Thai Art and Painting. At present, it offers 12 programs being 9 undergraduate programs, 2 master's programs and 1 doctoral program.
