The Faculty of Art and Industrial Design is the merging of two previous faculties — the Faculty of Art and the Faculty of Industrial Design; and Rajamangala University of Technology Isan was previously named Rajamangala Institute of Technology, Northeastern campus, Nakhon Ratchasima. When King Rama IX signed the “Rajamangala University of Technology Act” on January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2005, it resulted in the establishment of nine Rajamangala Universities of Technology and the change of the university’s name from “Rajamangala Institute of Technology, Northeastern campus, Nakhon Ratchasima” to “Rajamangala University of Technology Isan.”
