Faculty of Fine Arts and Architecture, Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna

The Faculty of Fine Arts and Architecture, Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna started by offering a vocational diploma program under the name of the "Department of Industrial Art" in 1962. Then the name was changed to the "Department of Product Design." Later, the Department of Architecture and the Department of Fine Arts were established.

In 1977, Payap College of Technology was given a new name as the "College of Technology and Vocational Education, Payap Campus. The objective was to expand the program to the undergraduate level. Then in 1988, King Rama IX renamed the College as "Rajamangala Technology Institute, Payap Campus," which later on was changed to "Rajamangala University of Technology.
