

College of Design, Rangsit University

In B.E. 2530, Dr. Arthit Ourairat saw the importance and value of art work and established the Faculty of Fine and Applied Arts, Rangsit University making it the first private university in Thailand to offer classes in arts and design. Ajarn Bunchop Palawong was the first Dean of the Faculty of Fine and Applied Arts at Rangsit University. There were 2 Departments: Fine Arts and Applied Arts with 8 Programs: Painting, Sculpture, Printmaking, Photography, Interior Design, Visual Communication Design, Product Design and Ceramic Porcelain.

In B.E. 2550, the Faculty of Fine and Applied Arts (former name) changed its name to the Faculty of Arts and Design to be in accordance with the increasing and diverse fields of studies. Thus, programs were updated and new ones developed for modernization such as the Computer Art Program and the Fashion Design Program.

In B.E. 2561, the Faculty changed its name again to College of Design which offers 5 Programs including Photography and Video Media, Interior Design, Visual Communication Arts, Fashion Design and Product Design. The current Dean is Associate Professor Pisrapai Sarasalin.
