

Conservatory of Music, Rangsit University

The Conservatory of Music, Rangsit University was established in 2002. It is the first private university to offer a Bachelor of Music program. The establishment of the Conservatory was made possible because of Dr. Arthit Ourairat's determination for Rangsit University to be the leading university in music education.

The Conservatory holds its pride as one of the music institutes in Thailand that has the same standard as other international universities. It is well-equipped with modern facilities. Its music technology center holds 6 recording studios, a number of private rehearsal studios, band rehearsal studios, classrooms for each instrument's practices, fully-equipped lecture rooms, *Suryadhep Music Sala* (a high-qualified concert hall), *Black Box Theater* (for musicals and contemporary music concerts), and a small concert hall for a more intimate musical experience.

At present, the Conservatory offers both Bachelor and Master of Music Program. It aims to produce music professionals who are honorable, who are well-educated in both music theories and practice, who can adapt and develop their knowledge and contribute to the society, and who can be a great support to the sustainability of national and international art and culture. The students who graduate from the Conservatory of Music are expected to be:

- the experts in their fields.
- able to effectively adapt their knowledge according to the surrounded music community.
- the exceptional musicians or singers.
- versatile and are able to perform with different types of music bands.
- musicians in recording studios.
- qualified music scholars.
- proficient university lecturers, school teachers, or music school teachers.
- composers and arrangers who have well-rounded understanding of different genres of music.
- skilled personnel that work behind-the-scenes in such roles as producers, sound engineers, show organizers, or personnel in every kind of music business.
